

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

NATIONAL SPORTS TRIBUNAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE PANEL

The National Sports Tribunal (NST) seeks expressions of interest from qualified legal practitioners with experience or interest in sports law to be included on the NST Legal Assistance Panel (NSTLAP).

It is expected that NSTLAP practitioners will be willing and able to provide part or full summary advice, procedural guidance and representational services *pro bono* or at a significantly reduced rate, to parties who have a current matter, or intend to bring a matter, to the NST.

Application Process

Practitioners interested in applying should consider the <u>NSTLAP Terms of Reference</u> and provide an Expression of Interest to the NST with:

- 1) an up-to-date curriculum vitae (max. two pages);
- 2) evidence of current practicing qualifications; and
- 3) a separate, brief statement of interest (max. one page) addressing the following matters:
 - experience or interest in sport law in Australia
 - experience in providing advice or representation in comparable arbitration, mediation, or conciliation processes
 - any areas of specialist interest and experience
 - willingness to provide legal assistance *pro bono* or at least at a substantially discounted rate in matters appearing before the NST
 - other relevant information.

Counsel should indicate whether they require a solicitor to also be engaged, or whether they are open to taking a direct brief.
